## Demonstrating Competence In High Risk Environments

**Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2007**

### TOPIC

- An invitation to a 45 minute Case Study presentation, demonstrating safety critical competence on an Upstream Oil & Gas Facility in less than 6 months.
- You are invited to a presentation by Alf Standen and Garry Eglinton, Directors of CIMA Pty Ltd, who will provide a Victorian case study on the application of a working model covering safety critical competencies in both on-shore and off-shore facilities. Increasingly regulators are looking more closely at the way competence is demonstrated and recorded in workplaces; and the case study will look at the way the model and its associated competence recording and maintenance system enabled definitive results and reduced expenditures on training in around 4½ months. The case study model was applied to experienced workers at a greenfield site but is equally useful on brownfield sites.
- While industry has been involved in the Australian competency system for over ten years, the question of the demonstration of competence is becoming an increasingly important one for high risk industries. Costs, security of information, the amount of time required to obtain a result, and the quality of the process have all been issues at some time and remain so. After many promises about the availability of a workable Recognition of Current Competence system the study demonstrates there is a light at the end of the tunnel.
- Spend 45 minutes of your time on a competence case study that will make you think about safety critical competence for your facility. This could save you and your organisation significant time and money in how you go about demonstrating the achievement of competence in your workplace.
- The seminar will include opportunities for participants to share their experiences on the subject and “compare notes”.
