

CALL FOR HOST ORGANISATIONS

Have a fresh set of enthusiastic eyes work on your problem for a week.

WHAT IS IT?

- The Science and Technology in Industry Program is for teams of tertiary students or teachers from Deakin University or the Gordon Institute of TAFE to work in a local industry on a technology based project.
- Each team will ideally consist of 4 participants: 2 from Science / Engineering / Technology and 2 from other disciplines from both Deakin and the Gordon. Separate teams will be formed of students and teachers/academics.
- Teams will receive one day's training in Quality principles and tools, effective teamwork and systematic problem solving as preparation for a work placement.
- Teams will spend 5 days working in a local Geelong industry on a real issue being experienced by that business. It will be real work in a real work environment.
- An Exhibition after the placement will showcase the teams' experiences and outcomes.

WHO IS IT FOR?

- Any local Geelong organization able to host 4 people for a week.
- The project tackled needs to be able to be presented in a public Exhibition of the team's work.

WHY BE INVOLVED?

- Have someone tackle that problem that you just have not had time to get around to looking at.
- Opportunity to evaluate students for potential vacation, project or graduate employment.
- Develop links with tertiary institutes.

WHEN IS IT?

- You must commit for the full program: one day's training, one week in industry, plus a 2-hour Exhibition of your team's findings.
- Training day: Thursday 1st December.
Five day work placement: Monday 5th to Friday 9th December.
Exhibition: Tuesday 13th December (4 - 6 pm)
- All costs for the program are covered by sponsorship of the Victorian State Government.
